

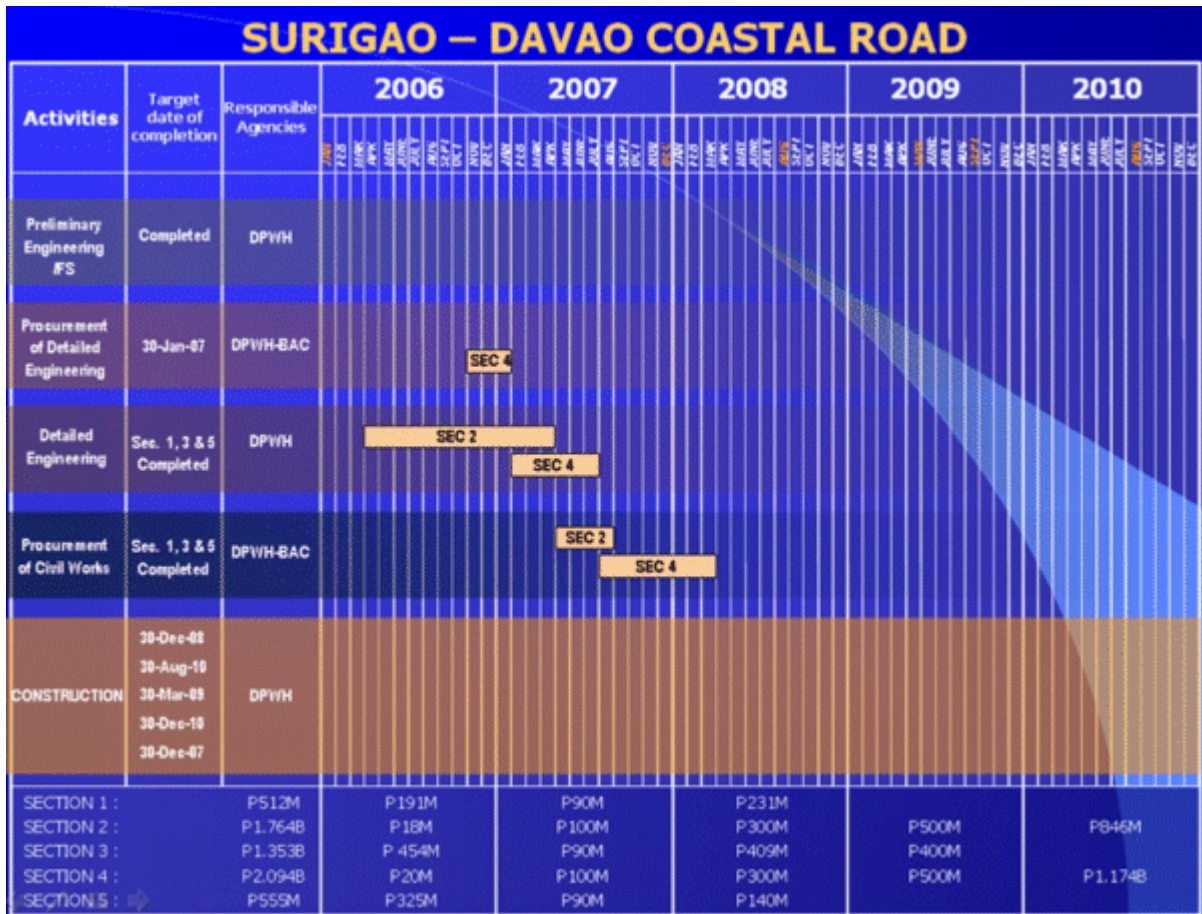

Tandag City, Surigao del Sur (20 June) -- President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo ordered the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) to fast track the construction of the Surigao-Davao Coastal Road project so that the development of the province would remain on course.

The President issued her instruction during her speech at the 48th Araw ng Surigao del Sur celebration held at the Tandag City Gymnasium here.

The President said the SDCR project should be completed at the soonest possible time as she promised Department of Public Works and Highways Regional Director Romeo Momo a promotion if he "does good" on her wishes.

"If you do this well, you won't be director for long because you will be undersecretary. So will you be giving the award today? Ok!," the President said.

The President, during her visit to nearby Carrascal town last April, said a large portion of the DPWH's budget had been allocated for the construction of the SDCR.

She said Surigao del Sur would receive a bulk of this big budget allocation - some P2-billion - for the construction of the Surigao-Davao Coastal Road (SDCR) project to complement the Claver-Carrascal Road project which is about to be completed.

Now with the General Appropriations Act of 2008 signed into law, the President told Momo that she wants the awarding of SDCR done today.

The SDCR is a SONA (State-of-the-Nation) priority project of the President and consists of concreting and road rehabilitation works on the nearly 84-kilometer stretch from Carrascal in the north to Lingig in the south.

"Spending on physical and human infrastructure remains central to the ability of our nation to break the historic cycle of despair and to meet the challenges of the future," the President said.

She added, however, that it was not "only on human and physical infrastructure" that was needed but on working to achieve long lasting peace as well.

"Because peace is (also) a central ingredient to the future of Surigao del Sur. It is a path we remain firmly committed to achieving which includes defeating the NPA (new people's army) and returning the countryside to the people," the President said.

Bidding for SDS portion of Surigao-Davao Coastal Road to push through

Tandag, Surigao del Sur (August 10) -- DPWH Regional Director Romeo Momo announced that the scheduled bidding of the large portion of the Surigao - Davao Coastal Road within Surigao del Sur highway will push through as scheduled.

The project that costs around P1B will start from the town of Marihatag up to the junction of Hinatuan or a total of 62 kilometers stretch including the concreting of 17 bridges.

Dir. Momo said no less than Pres. Gloria Macapagal Arroyo ordered the said bidding so he is hopeful the project will no longer be delayed as in previous bidding.

The project has long been awaited by the people of Surigao del Sur because when finally implemented, this will drastically ease the sacrifices of the commuters every time they travel. People here have been suffering for decades now because of the bumpy roads especially during rainy season.

The project is also identified to be a major factor in hastening the economic development of the province when businessmen will then be encouraged to put-up capital here.

RD Momo said the project is already a part of the mega-region program of the Arroyo administration.
